Health & Safety Training ...for legal compliance

By law, employers have a duty to provide information and instruction to workers to protect their health and safety. Training is the key way employers meet this general obligation.

Health and safety law also spells out specific mandatory training requirements. For instance, Ontario's *Occupational Health & Safety Act (the Act)* requires the establishment of a joint health and safety committee (JHSC) in most workplaces with 20 or more workers. Employers must ensure one member representing workers on the JHSC and one representing management complete a **two-step Certification Training process**. This includes *Basic Certification Part I* and *Workplace Hazard-Specific Training also known as Certification Part II*.

Additional mandatory health and safety training requirements relate to:

- **general health and safety awareness (both worker and supervisor)**
- **violence and harassment**
- **WHMIS**
- **confined space entry**
- **operation of mobile equipment**
- **working at heights.**

Employers across Ontario from all sectors of the economy have turned to the Workers Health & Safety Centre (WHSC) to help them gain compliance with their extensive mandatory training obligations.
