WORKERS HEALTH & SAFETY CENTRE

LEVEL I FEDERAL

Program Description

The Workers Centre's programs are developed to provide in-depth health and safety training to participants, and the learning objectives set for each session meet this goal. Upon completion of WHSC training, the Centre issues a certificate of participation.

Level I embraces an entire gamut of health and safety issues by focusing on hazard recognition and the rights and responsibilities of the workplace parties, as prescribed by existing legislation. This 30-hour key program consists of 10 modules which include seven core modules that identify the respective roles of the workplace parties – management, government and labour regarding health and safety; explains current health and safety legislation, provincial or federal; discusses how the body functions and the damaging effects hazards have on it; features carcinogens, and how to recognize them and toxic substances, as well as their sources; explains the effectiveness, or lack of, the three basic principles of control – at the source, along the path, and at the worker; and identifies the hazards presented by excessive workplace noise, and tells how to measure workplace noise and how to develop a noise abatement program.

Over 25 modules have been developed by the WHSC at the introductory level for worker audiences – these are collectively referred to as Level I modules.

To earn a Level I certificate a participant must complete seven core modules including one of the core legislation modules (either federal or provincial) and three additional electives. The eight core modules are:

1. Staying Alive While Earning A Living
2. The Body and the Workplace
3. Cancer
4. Toxic Substances
5. Principles of Control
6. Provincial Legislation
7. Federal Legislation
8. Safety and the Myth of Worker Carelessness
