GET STARTED

The Occupational Health & Safety Act (*the Act*) requires the establishment of a joint health and safety committee (JHSC) in most workplaces employing 20 or more workers. *The Act* also requires employers to ensure one member representing workers and one representing management completes a two-step **Certification Training** process. The WHSC is a leading provider of *Basic Certification Training* or *Certification Part I* and *Workplace Hazard-Specific Training* or *Certification Part II*.

Mandatory *Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System* (WHMIS) training for your workforce as well as training designed to build supervisor health and safety competency are just two of many additional programs the WHSC regularly schedules.
