

pain and disability. Loss of livelihood and dignity. Musculoskeletal disorders (MSDs) plague more Ontario workers than any other work-related injury or illness. MSDs account for about 40 per cent of all approved lost-time injury claims in Ontario a rate stubbornly unchanged for decades. Despite efforts to prevent MSDs, much more is needed to end this suffering.

Workers and their representatives are asking and seeking answers to some tough questions:

Why do workers continue to suffer MSDs in such great numbers?

Why are interventions not more effective?

What do we need in order to move from pain to prevention?
