

Certification Part II Manufacturing & Fabricating Sector Program

Before JHSC members can become fully certified, they are required to complete a second round of training commonly known as Certification Part II training. This training is designed to help certified representatives identify, assess and control, or better yet eliminate, hazards specific to their workplace. To meet this requirement workplace representatives can choose from WHSC Certification Part II hazard-specific training modules organized into Workplace Safety & Insurance Board-audited and approved sector programs or they can take a more custom approach selecting from over 60 WHSC hazard modules (see the product sheet entitled, WHSC Workplace Training Programs).

Our sector programs meet the needs of workplaces typical to the sector. These programs allow workplaces to get into compliance fast. Training secured in this manner is also portable between workplaces in the sector. If workplaces opt for a custom program, employers in consultation with the JHSC must conduct a workplace hazard assessment including a list of training that meets identified hazards.

The Program: By day, by hazard module (French Available) (15 hazards – 5 days)

Day 1: Confined Spaces; Lockout; Moving Machine Parts

Day 2: Electrical Hazards; Hand Tools; Noise

Day 3: Compressed Gas; Welding Hazards; Indoor Air Quality & Ventilation

Day 4: Manual Material Handling; Conveyor Systems; Forklift Trucks

Day 5: Walking & Working Surfaces; Personal Protective Equipment; Emergency Preparedness & Pandemic Response Plans
