This requirement comes into force April 1, 2015. Fall protection includes travel restraint systems, fall restricting systems, fall arrest systems, safety nets and work belts or safety belts.

WHSC Working at Heights training was one of the first to receive **MOL approval**. After successfully completing our program, participants receive a WHSC record of training card valid for three years. And because WHSC keeps complete records of all training, WHSC can provide complete training transcripts or replacement cards on request.
